

SAMPLE ***Educational Progress Evaluation Form***

For use by evaluators



Note to Evaluators:

One of the most important things to determine is whether your child is making educational progress in accordance with his or her abilities. Your evaluation should explain how this goal has been met.

Use some type of form to document your evaluations. Feel free to photocopy this form or use another one that better suits your needs.

Note to Parents:

The more severe the special learning need, the more regular the evaluations should be. Evaluations can be done in person or over the telephone. However, we recommend that you use the most direct method of evaluation available to you.

If the evaluation indicates that adequate progress has not been made, you may want to take additional steps to assure that your child's special learning needs are being met.

Keep evaluation records in your possession for a minimum of three years or until your child is well beyond compulsory school age. (Please be aware that children with severe special learning needs can be subject to state and federal education regulations beyond normal compulsory school age.)

Do not forward evaluations to HSLDA; we will request them if the need arises to defend your homeschool.
