One of the most important ways to prevent disease is through routine immunizations. The Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) indicates that _____ may be due for the following immunizations: DTP/DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap, Varicella, HPV, Hepatitis A, Seasonal Influenza and Meningococcal Conjugate.

What you have to do:

- Please call your doctor or Health Department to make an appointment.
- Make sure to bring this notice with you to the appointment.
- Have your doctor or Health Department update MCIR records so all immunizations are recorded.
- Ask for a copy of the updated immunization record for you to keep at home.
- **If you think Faith has already received these immunizations, please call your your doctor or Health Department, so that they can update the MCIR records.**

Together we can help protect against vaccine preventable diseases. Starting and completing the series of HPV vaccine can protect against cancer later. Please call your physicians office or local health department with questions or to schedule an appointment.
