**My wife and I are the parents and teachers for our son, David Smith. We have homeschooled him the past \_\_\_\_\_ years. We are homeschool parents who are homeschooling in accordance with the law in our state.**

- **Provide him with extra time for all assignments, especially those involving reading and writing. During testing he is provided extra time up to double the amount normally provided. - **Provide oral testing.**
- **We do not require David to read aloud unless he volunteers.**
- **We do not count off for spelling on written assignments.**
- **Any classes he happens to take outside the home, including his dual enrollment classes at \_\_\_\_\_, we make the university, community college, or homeschool co-op teachers or professors aware of his dyslexia, and he is provided accommodations as further documented on the report by the diagnostician.**
